Last month, the National Hockey League announced an expansion franchise would be coming to Vegas. That team would need a home. T-Mobile Arena will fill that void. The \$375 million facility, located just west of the Las Vegas strip, wrapped up construction in April after about 2 years of work. Populous, a part of the HOK group, designed the arena while Penta Building Group and Hunt Construction Group were the general contractors on the project. Thornton Tomasetti provided structural engineering services.
